**Declaration on the transporting of PRO-X Lithium-Ion Batteries under the 44th Edition of the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations effective 1 January 2003.**

2. PRO-X hereby declares that the battery pack models listed above have aggregate equivalent lithium content well below the 8g requirement:

3. Acceptable without operator approval

The IATA 44 th Edition on the TRANSPORT OF DANGEROUS GOODS REGULATIONS states that lithium-ion batteries offered for transport are NOT subject to these regulations if the aggregate (total) equivalent lithium content per battery is not more than 8g.

The aggregate equivalent lithium content in the PRO-X battery packs stipulated above is not more than 8g.

Therefore the GP-L90B, GP-L90AB, XP-L60S, XP-L60A, XP-L90S, XP-L90A, XP-L60SD, XP-L60AD, XP-L90SD, XP-L90AD, Intellicom 90A, Intellicom 90A, NP-L50 and NP-L60, when packed so as to prevent short circuit, are NOT subject to transport control by these regulations.
